

Pig Hub – Who can see my data

Access to data for a **producer holding** within Pig Hub is determined by the Primary contact.

The Primary contact:

The Primary contact of the producer holding can view and edit all holding data on Pig Hub. They can also assign additional contacts, vet practices, corporate groups, marketing groups and agents to the holding.

The Primary contact can access the following AHDB services through Pig Hub:

- Setup movements on eAML2
- Sign up to the Significant Diseases Charter
- Enter medicine usage data and submit total antibiotic usage returns on eMB-Pigs
- Complete biosecurity and salmonella risk assessments.

Once assigned by the primary contact, the following users have access to selected data on Pig Hub as below:

Corporate group primary contact:

The primary contact of the assigned corporate group has the same access as the producer primary contact.

Additional producer contacts and additional corporate group contacts:

Additional contacts can view the holding data on Pig Hub and access the following services:

- Setup movements on eAML2
- View medicine usage data and total antibiotic usage returns on eMB-Pigs
- Complete biosecurity and salmonella risk assessments.

Vet practice contacts:

Pig Hub allows producer and corporate group primary contacts to assign their vet practice to different AHDB services on Pig Hub. There are three services:

- **eAML2** – This will populate the eAML2 haulier summary with the details of the vet practice assigned. Pig Hub users from this vet practice will see a list of their clients' holdings, along with their address and the name of the primary contact. They will also be able to view and complete the biosecurity and salmonella risk assessments. All holdings should have an eAML2 vet practice assigned
- **RT Pigs** – This is the vet practice assigned to carry out Red Tractor Real Welfare assessments. Contacts from this vet practice will be able to access their clients' assessment data on the Real Welfare I-Pig website and app. All assured finisher units should have a RT Pigs vet practice assigned
- **Pig Health** – Contacts from this vet practice are able to notify AHDB of disease outbreaks from producers signed up to the Disease Charter. By assigning a vet practice to this service the primary contact gives permission for contacts of the vet practice to view their medicine usage data on eMB-Pigs.

Marketing group contacts:

Contacts of a marketing group can view a list of their clients' holdings, along with their addresses and the names of the primary contacts. They can access the following service:

- Setup, cancel and confirm movements on eAML2. They are only able to cancel or confirm movements that they have set up.

Agents:

Agents are assigned by the producer or corporate group primary contact to individual holdings to perform one of two tasks on behalf of the primary contact:

- **eAML2 Agents** will be able to setup, cancel and confirm movements on eAML2. They are also able to access the eAML2 movement archive
- **eMB-Pigs Agents** will be able to enter medicine usage data and total antibiotic usage data on eMB-Pigs, and save a draft antibiotic usage return. They are not able to submit the return, however. They are also able to view historical data and holding reports on eMB-Pigs.

AHDB:

AHDB accesses data on Pig Hub for the following purposes:

- For purposes relating to disease prevention and control
- To send you knowledge transfer information and updates on issues we think will be of value to you
- To contact you occasionally to inform you of new services AHDB will be providing, or events or information we think will be of value to you
- To internally administer this website and help us improve our services.
